DR. DAVID GRAFTON TO TEACH AND PREACH AT CALVARY We are very pleased that Dr. David Grafton will be with us on Sunday, February 21, to preach at both of our services. Dr. Grafton will also lead an adult discussion between services at 9:15am. The Rev. Dr. David D. Grafton is Associate Professor, Islamic Studies and Christian-Muslim Relations and Vice President for Planning, Assessment, and Administration at our Lutheran Seminary in Philadelphia. He has a PhD in Islamic Studies from the University of Birmingham, UK. Before joining the Philadelphia faculty he served as the Coordinator of Graduate Studies at the Evangelical Theological Seminary of Cairo, Egypt. Dr. Grafton has provided courses, lectures and seminars on Islam, Middle East Religion and Society, and Christian-Muslim Relations around the world, including Jordan, Lebanon, Egypt and Sudan, England, and within the United States. He is the author of numerous articles on Christian-Muslim Relations in the Middle East. We are looking forward to Dr. Grafton's visit to Calvary. We encourage you to invite your neighbors and friends to this special opportunity as we seek to learn more about being good neighbors to those of the Muslim faith.
